3. NY Water Environment Association Paul Farrell Jr Scholarship

4. Scholarships for Students with Parents with Disabilities

A high school senior planning to attend college in the fall with at least one parent with a disability may apply for this \$1000 award. Please see guidance
Application with essay must be submitted by **March 16, 2009**

5. NY Rural Water Association

A \$500 award will be given to a student that resides on a water system that is a member of NYRWA . GPA, leadership, and financial need will be considered for this award. See guidance for application Deadline is **March 18, 2009**

6. Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr Scholarship

This scholarship award is given based on an essay, financial need, academic record, service to school, faith, and society and personal goals. For application please see guidance. **Deadline is March 31, 2009**

7. Junior League of Albany Rockwell Scholarship Award

A female high school senior who is a resident of the capital district may apply for this \$1000 award. Must currently be involved in volunteer organizations and be able to demonstrate citizenship and initiative by way of essay. Please see guidance for information **Deadline is April 1, 2009**

8. The Amy Bindelglass Memorial Scholarship

Any high school junior or senior may apply to this award by submitting an essay answering a question on the topic of organ donation. One first place winner will receive \$500, and one second place winner will receive \$200. For application please see guidance. **Deadline is April 1, 2009**

9. Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship

This \$5000 scholarship is distributed in \$625 per semester to one graduating senior from the each participating high school in NYS. Student leaders who demonstrate strong academic performance, participate in extracurricular activities, and display a commitment to community service are encouraged to apply for this award. See guidance for application. **Deadline is April 1, 2009**

10. Town of New Scotland Historical Association Award

A \$500 award will e given to a senior who is a serious student planning on concentrating in some area of history at the college level. Applications and essay topic will be available in guidance. **Deadline is April 8, 2009**

13. NY State Assoc of Agricultural Fairs

Awards six \$1,000 scholarships to those high school students who have been active in their local fairs and who intend to pursue or who are pursuing higher education in a field related to agriculture, fair management or the outdoor amusement business. 14. Tri-County Council Vietnam Veterans

Scholarships of \$1000 are awarded to children and grandchildren of Veterans of all conflicts who served in active duty. Proof must be provided, along with an essay, application, and school record. Please see guidance for application.

15. American Society of Civil Engineers

Graduating seniors seeking to continue education to become a practicing civil engineer may apply for this \$1000 yearly award. For application please see guidance.

Deadline is **April 17, 2009**

16. National Association of Women in Construction

Female high school seniors planning on pursuing a career in a construction-related field of study are welcome to apply for this award. The \$500 scholarship is awarded based on need, merit, and review of transcript. For application please see guidance.

Deadline is **April 20, 2009**

17. Guilderland Pop Warner Scholarship

19. Capital District Counseling Association

20. Julia Wells Memorial Education Foundation

A graduating senior who plans on pursuing a career in professional nursing may apply for this \$250 award. You must provide a letter of acceptance into a two or four year accredited nursing program. For application see guidance.

21. Lawrence Madeiros Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to a high school senior that has been diagnosed with a bleeding disorder or other chronic disorder. You must have been accepted at an accredited college. For application and rules please see guidance. **Deadline is June 1, 2009**

22. Garden Study Club of America

A scholarship fund is awarded to encourage the study of horticulture, gardening, floral design, and the environment. Recipients can be any individual or program that fulfills this purpose.
